How we have flourished this week!

Seedlings and Acorns

This week in nursery, we made colourful windsocks to decorate our outdoor area, using a variety of joining techniques. We also focused on numeral formation by 'driving' around numbered roads and used water to paint away chalk numerals.

Maple

This week in Maple Class, the children have been developing their writing skills by creating postcards inspired by *The Snail and the Whale*. They carefully thought about the journey in the story and used their imagination to write the beginnings of a postcard.

Oak

This week, Oak class said goodbye to Miss Ali who has helped them grow and flourish since January. Before she went she taught them about freezing and melting using fun, practical science investigations.

Ash

We enjoyed a wonderful trip to the Lookout Discovery Centre. The children explored lots of different hands-on science activities and were very engaged in the workshop and fieldwork about bugs.

Willow

In RE we discussed Jesus' statement, 'I am the true vine' and in Maths continued their new shape topic learning about properties of lines. We had such an amazing time at Sports Day to end our week!

Cedar

Throughout this week in English, we have been exploring the picture book *Float* to inspire our narrative writing through our sentence stacking lessons. In Maths, we have continued our learning on statistics by collecting, interpreting and presenting data in a variety of ways.

Sycamore

In English, we have continued exploring *Journey to Jo'burg*, thinking carefully about the themes of courage, friendship and equality. In Science, we completed our water resistance investigations, testing a range of different shapes to discover which moved most effectively through water and discussing what made our tests fair.

Redwood

We have been busy making props and getting ready for our production. A replica of R2-D2 has even appeared in our classroom ready for the show! We also had an amazing time at Thorpe Park and on our Year 6 Partnership sports day this week!



Thought for the week



He got up, rebuked the wind and said to the waves, "Quiet! Be still!" Then the wind died down and it was completely calm. *Mark 4:39*

Storms come in many forms. Sometimes they are the storms we can see, such as heavy rain and strong winds. More often, they are the storms we feel inside - when we are worried, upset, afraid or unsure about what lies ahead.

In this Bible story, the disciples were frightened as the waves crashed around their boat. They thought they were alone in the storm, but Jesus was with them all along. With just a few words, "Quiet! Be still!", the storm came to an end.

Although we all face difficult moments, this reminds us that we never have to face them on our own. Jesus brings peace, courage and hope, even when life feels unsettled. Sometimes the storm around us may not disappear straight away, but we can ask Jesus to calm the storm within us, helping us to think clearly, act kindly and trust that brighter days are ahead.

This week, when you feel overwhelmed or worried, take a quiet moment to pause, breathe and remember Jesus' words: "Quiet! Be still!" Let them remind you that God is always with you, bringing peace into every situation.

Dear Lord,

Thank you for always being with us, especially when life feels difficult or uncertain. When our hearts are full of worry or fear, help us to hear your gentle words: "Quiet! Be still!"
