# How we have flourished this week!

## Seedlings and Acorns

This week in Nursery we have explored different artistic techniques, by using toothbrushes to create starry night pictures and using pens then spraying water to make colourful planets. We have been finding ways to keep cool and have had lots of fun!

## Maple

This week, Maple Class have been working incredibly hard during their Phonics assessments. They have approached the assessments with enthusiasm and determination, demonstrating just how much progress they have made throughout the year.

## Oak

This week, year one have been learning about the value of numbers up to 100 in maths, have started writing a poem in English and looked at the parable of the Wise and Foolish men in RE. They have done so well to keep their cool!

## Ash

In maths, we have been learning to draw and interpret pictograms, block diagrams and tables, as part of our 'statistics' topic. I am hugely proud of the children for their focus and effort during our assessments at the start of the week.

## Willow

This week, Willow have been drawing pictograms and block graphs in maths. We have also been continuing to practice using analogue clocks for real purposes, supporting our future learning.

## Cedar

This week in Year 4, the children coped brilliantly with the hot weather. They worked hard during their assessments and should be proud of their effort. We also began planning and designing our 3D structures, creating thoughtful designs.

## Sycamore

This week, we have planned an investigation to test water resistance and continued reading Journey to Jo'burg in Destination Reader, where we discussed apartheid. Everyone has also tried extremely hard in all their assessments and shown great perseverance. Well done, Year 5!

## Redwood

This week, Redwood took part in the It's Your Move workshop with Rev. Ann to support transition to secondary school, and in Art they analysed three artists while in History they explored the Blitz and Battle of Britain using oral and visual sources.
