## UPDATE FROM MR SZURGOT

Thank you to everyone who attended our recent Parents' Evening. It was wonderful to catch up with so many of you and to hear how proud you are of your children and the progress they are making. These conversations are always such an important part of our partnership with families, and it was a real pleasure to celebrate the children's achievements together. Thank you as well for taking the time to complete our Parent Survey. It was fantastic to see the positive responses that you gave to all the work we do here at Holy Trinity.

Over the past two weeks, children across the school have also been completing their assessments. We are incredibly proud of the way they approached these with such hard work, resilience and determination. The children have shown great focus and maturity, and it has been lovely to see the progress they have made so far this year reflected in their efforts.

On Tuesday, our Year 5 pupils took part in Pedestrian Training. During the session, they learned how to cross the road safely by remembering four important steps: Stop, Look, Listen and Think. They practised stopping at the edge of the pavement, looking both ways for traffic, listening carefully for approaching vehicles and thinking about whether it was safe to cross. The children represented the school brilliantly and did a fantastic job learning these important road safety skills.

# How we have flourished this week!

## Seedlings and Acorns

We have had a busy week in Nursery, learning about all things under the sea. The children have enjoyed counting the fish they caught and creating wonderful craft sea animals. In RE we continued our learning about Easter.

## Maple

In Maple this week we have been talking about sharing in PSHE. We looked at why sharing is important and how it makes us feel to share and have someone share with us. In Maths we began exploring length and height.

## Oak

Oak class have been learning about the Last Supper in RE and what that event teaches Christians about Jesus. In science, they were learning about fish and how these animals differ from mammals and birds. In art, they were busy mixing secondary colours.

## Ash

This week the children were excited to use paint to mix the three primary colours in different combinations in order to make secondary colours. In music we creatively interpreted a piece through drawing. Some children drew 'angry', red lines as the music grew louder, and calm, blue waves when calmer.

## Willow

This week, Willow have begun planning their castles. We have been thinking carefully about our cutting skills to ensure that our castles are strong - as they need to be for defense!

## Cedar

The children developed their understanding of improper fractions and mixed numbers. In science, they explored how sound is made, identified which parts of instruments vibrate to produce sound, and investigated different mediums it can travel through.

## Sycamore

We looked at the Great Barrier Reef as part of our Geography topic. We learnt where it is located, the benefits it provides, and the threats it is currently facing. We also took part in pedestrian training where we learnt how to cross the road safely.

## Redwood

This week, the children explored where solar panels would work best in school in Geography, began learning The White Cliffs of Dover, and learned in Science about adaptation and how offspring inherit characteristics from their parents to help them survive in their habitat.
