How we have flourished this week!

Seedlings and Acorns

This week in Nursery, we have been learning about planting and growing. We read Jasper's Beanstalk and planted beans, sunflower seeds, and vegetables. We learnt how to care for plants and discovered plants need a lot of the things we need to grow.

Maple

This week in Maple Class, the children have been learning about 2D shapes in Maths. They explored the different ways shapes can be rotated and combined to create new pictures and patterns, showing great creativity and problem-solving skills.

Oak

Oak have been thinking about how the seasons might affect a sycamore tree and writing about it in English. In DT, they have planned and made a fruit salad for their families to share for dessert. They have also started learning about fractions in maths.

Ash

We made healthy wraps in DT on Tuesday! The children practiced skills of grating, spreading and chopping, to create a wrap which included protein, carbohydrates and fruit/vegetables. In maths, we had the water tray out and were investing volume and capacity.

Willow

Willow have made their own zines, using them to create 'self portraits' by including those things which are most important to them. In maths, we have been learning about money, focusing on recognising coins and then adding and subtracting different amounts.

Cedar

The children explored newspaper reports about plastic pollution and began writing their own. They also started creating picture books about seasonal changes affecting wildlife and continued practising times tables ahead of their multiplication check after half term.

Sycamore

This week, we wrote our own poems inspired by the poem, 'The Most Dangerous Animal in the World' by Valerie Bloom. We also learnt about the importance of the Silk Road in History and finished our Maths unit on shape.

Redwood

Year 6 enjoyed their residential trip to Wales, where they took part in a range of activities and developed valuable teamwork and problem-solving skills. They also helped build props for the production, went swimming, and enjoyed a fun day at Ruislip Lido.
