How we have flourished this week!

Seedlings and Acorns

This week in Nursery, we have loved reading and joining in with the stories *Shark in the Park* and *Shark in the Dark*. The children then had great fun independently making telescopes and using them to retell the stories.

Maple

the children have been learning about addition and subtraction in Maths, developing their confidence with numbers. In RE, we explored why a Gurdwara is a special place for Sikhs and learned more about the importance of kindness and community.

Oak

This week, Oak Class learned about how Muslims practice Wudu before prayer and impressed with their knowledge of Islam. They also had a great time identifying different animal groups at London Zoo.

Ash

In DT this week, we enjoyed taste testing different foods, like avocado, houmous and spinach leaves. We will be making healthy wraps next week and have been learning about having a balanced diet. In Geography we wrote a radio advert for visiting Weymouth!

Willow

This week, Willow have been making 'tines' in Art. We have used our tines as 'self portraits', including the things that are most important to us. In Science, we are continuing to investigate plants.

Cedar

The children explored the importance of community in RE. In maths they began learning about money comparing and converting pounds and pence. In geography the children discovered why rivers are useful and how they support our lives.

Sycamore

We have built and tested different sized parachutes, researched Islamic scholars, measured and drawn angles with a protractor, written and practiced our class assembly next week, started to write our own rhyming poems and finally read how Liam and Florida came to be stuck in space in our book, *Cosmic*.

Redwood

Redwood showed outstanding dedication during their SATs this week, completing six English and Maths papers with great focus and perseverance. To celebrate, the pupils enjoyed a fun-filled sports afternoon at BWI with Trailblazers!



Thought for the week



While Paul was waiting for them in Athens, he was greatly distressed to see that the city was full of idols. Acts 17:16

This week's Bible verse reminds us that when Paul visited Athens, he noticed that many people were focusing their attention on idols instead of on God. Today, we may not have statues or temples in the same way, but there are still things that can sometimes take up too much of our attention — such as always wanting more possessions, spending too much time worrying about what others think, or focusing only on ourselves.

Paul's reaction teaches us the importance of keeping our hearts and minds centred on what truly matters: kindness, love, truth and our relationship with God.

At school, this can encourage us to think carefully about the choices we make each day. Are we making time to care for others? Are we being thankful for what we already have? Are we showing our school values in the way we speak and act? When we focus on the right things, we grow into people who help others flourish and make our community a happier and more caring place to be.
