# How we have flourished this week!



## Seedlings and Acorns

Nursery children have been learning about jungle animals and created some colourful parrots, wonderful stripy tigers and spotty leopards. We have also read the Easter story and discussed what Easter eggs may symbolise.

## Maple

This week, in Phonics, we began revising our Phase 3 sounds and tricky words. In PSHE we were learning about different festivals from around the world and spoke about different ways our families celebrate occasions. In Maths we began doubling numbers to 8.

## Oak

Another busy week in Oak Class! After learning about birds in science and then using facts about flamingos and rhinos in our English, we are practically zoologists! We also really enjoyed the story telling session at St Martins school for World Book Day.

## Ash

In music this week we listen to 'Mars' from The Planets by Holst. We talked about how the tempo and dynamics changed to move the music between exciting and calm. We then layered our own space soundscape. In RE we learnt how different symbols help us tell the Easter story.

## Willow

Willow have continued to learn about the Roman Empire. We were amazed to see the progress of their army and why they invaded Britain. In English we started to write our own stories, based on the Grandma in 'George's Marvelous Medicine'.

## Cedar

We began our new topic on rainforests, exploring the world's different biomes and learning about the layers of the rainforest. In RE, we discussed and analysed bible verses linked to the Last Supper, thinking about their meaning and why this is important for Christians.

## Sycamore

We attended an engaging presentation from the author Chris Bradford, where he demonstrated his samurai skills and talked about what inspired him to write. We also watched an amazing production of The Lion, the Witch and the Wardrobe at Bishop Ramsey.

## Redwood

This week, Redwood visited St Martin's school for an author talk with Chris Bradford. The children were inspired by his stories, passion for writing, and his demonstration in iaido (samurai swordsmanship). In PE, Redwood have been honing their tennis skills, focusing on returning the ball effectively against their opponents.

# Is your child registered for SCHOOL MILK?

**Child UNDER 5**

Every child under the age of five is entitled to free school milk. Simply register your child online.



**Child OVER 5**

Every child over the age of five is entitled to milk at a subsidised cost of around £20 per term. Register your child and pay online.

Children in receipt of benefits-based free school meals are eligible for free school milk. Speak to the school for further information.

Free milk for under 5s is funded by the Department of Health and milk for over 5s is subsidised by DEFRA.
