## UPDATE FROM MR SZURGOT

From engaging lessons to creative indoor playtimes, the children's enthusiasm and positivity have really shone.

I have also been incredibly impressed while reading the children's First of the Month books. It has been a real joy to see the clear progress they are making month on month, whether in presentation, confidence, stamina or the quality of their work. These books are a wonderful reflection of the children's hard work and of the care staff put into helping every child grow and flourish.

Looking ahead, Children's Mental Health Week takes place next week, and this year's theme is This is My Place. The focus is on helping children feel a strong sense of belonging within their families, friendships and school community and, for us as a Christian school, as part of God's family, so that every child feels connected, valued, accepted, safe and ready to learn.

Throughout the week, the children will take part in a range of activities linked to this theme, including whole-school and class-based assemblies, PSHE and art lessons focused on personal identity and belonging, and a live Picture News assembly. These activities will culminate in a non-uniform day on Friday 13 February, when children are invited to wear their brightest or most colourful clothes or accessories to celebrate community and belonging. A £1 donation is suggested.

This week provides a valuable opportunity to remind our children that they matter, that they belong, and that they are an important part of our school family.

# How we have flourished this week!

## Seedlings and Acorns

This week Nursery children have been busy learning about vets and counting treats for our 'puppy'. As part of our RE learning, the children enjoyed creating collages of their faces, celebrating how we are all unique in our own special way.

## Maple

We read the parable of Jesus healing the paralysed man and spoke about people who help us. In Maths we looked at a new concept, mass, and began learning the difference between heavier and lighter. In Music we were looking at songs with actions.

## Oak

This week Oak have learned about the sense of taste in science. They observed their taste buds carefully and then tested them on different foods. In PSHE, they interviewed various members of staff about their roles in school and the skills needed to perform them.

## Ash

In our Science lesson this week, we tested how the strength of paper can be changed by folding it. We built 15cm bridges using A4 paper folded in different ways. We discovered that folding the sheet into quarters and then folding the sides increases its strength.

## Willow

We have continued to work on multiplication in Maths. Using Times Table Rock Stars helps us a lot! We started to look at a new text in English entitled 'The Street Beneath My Feet' and are really looking forward to sharing our assembly with you next week!

## Cedar

This week in Year 4, the children enjoyed creating a water cycle in a jar to help them understand how water changes state. In Maths, they began learning how to find the perimeter of rectilinear shapes and practised converting lengths.

## Sycamore

We explored inventories and what they can tell us about everyday life in Tudor times, helping us to understand how people lived. In Science, we investigated sundials, learning how they tell the time, when they were used and why they were important.

## Redwood

This week, Redwood began exploring evolution and inheritance. We discussed which characteristics can be inherited from our parents and introduced the concept of natural selection. Pupils then applied their learning by researching an animal, which they will use as the focus for a non-chronological report in our writing lessons.
