How we have flourished this week!

Seedlings and Acorns

We have been exploring shape and pattern in a variety of ways. We made patchwork Elmer's and snail's inspired by Matisse. We also tested a variety of objects to see if they would float or sink. As part of our RE we thought about how to look after our world.

Maple

Maple class have been exploring the differences between 2D and 3D shapes, developing their understanding through a range of engaging activities. In English, pupils enjoyed tasting and explaining the flavours of the fruits mentioned in Handa's Surprise!

Oak

In RE, we have been studying Islam, where we explored a range of artefacts to help us understand the religion better. In Geography, we have planned a neighbourhood walk to observe our surroundings for today.

Ash

In geography we started talking about what it is like to live on the coast. We used google maps to look at the features of coastal towns and used key words like 'cliff', 'dunes', 'coastline' and 'harbour'. We drew diagrams of plants in science, labelling what they need in order to be rooted, to grow and flourish!

Willow

This week, Willow have been working with fractions in Maths. In Geography, we have continued to learn about Antarctica and in PE have been enjoying building our athletics skills ready for Sports Day!

Cedar

We enjoyed our trip to the Science Museum, where the children especially loved exploring the Wonderlab and its interactive exhibits. In geography, they began learning about the course of a river, including the key features found in the upper, middle, and lower stages.

Sycamore

In Science, we explored air resistance. We investigated how air can slow objects down and discussed real-life examples, such as parachutes and falling objects. In History, we learned about life in Baghdad during the Golden Age of Islam.

Redwood

This week Redwood took part in their Mock SATs in preparation for the real exams in May. They all tried incredibly hard and should be very proud of themselves! In our History lessons, Year 6 learned about the events leading up to WW2.



Thought for the week



When I am afraid, I put my trust in you
Psalm 56:3

We all feel afraid sometimes. We might worry about a test, feel nervous about trying something new, or be unsure about a difficult situation. Even grown-ups have moments when they feel worried or uncertain. The Bible reminds us in Psalm 56:3, "When I am afraid, I put my trust in you."
