How we have flourished this week!

Seedlings and Acorns

This week we have been busy making castles from 2d and 3d shapes. We discussed why the cross is an important symbol to Christians and we also looked at the many countries, and their flags, that we have connections to in Nursery.

Maple

This week in Maple Class, the children have continued their learning about grouping in Maths. They have been practising counting in 2s and using their knowledge to create some fantastic number sentences.

Oak

This week, Oak Class have made a great start to their new English unit on 'The Way Back Home', including producing artwork depicting the phases of the moon. They have also done really well in the Phonics Screening Tests!

Ash

We have started planning a diary entry, writing as the main character in our fiction text, 'Anna Hibiscus and the Big Holiday'. We have enjoyed lots of discussion about inference; reading between the lines and being 'detectives'. In RE we talked about the significance of baptism as a Christian ceremony.

Willow

This week, Willow have continued learning about Indian music, playing a 'Rag' on the glockenspiels. In D&T, we have begun planning our Egyptian collars, marking the start of our new summer sewing project!

Cedar

This week, Year 4 completed their Multiplication Tables Check (MTC). In history, they began their new topic on the Anglo-Saxons, exploring why they settled in Britain and examining some of the key causes and consequences of their arrival and settlement.

Sycamore

This week in Sycamore we have been writing a descriptive portal story, learning to add and subtract to 2 decimal places, watched an oceans live lesson with Steve Backshall and investigated the places of worship that are near us.

Redwood

This week Year 6 auditioned for the production and began reading through the script. They also explored pneumatics in DT and made their own models of tipping trucks, using two syringes, beams and girders.
