# How we have flourished this week!

## Seedlings and Acorns

We have been learning about minibeasts. The children have loved creating a variety of creatures using playdough and hunting for bug hunts in our outdoor area. We have also made the most of the sunshine and created small Easter gardens.

## Maple

We explored height and length, and even measured ourselves to see how tall we are growing. In RE, we talked about why the cross is special to Christians and what it represents. We also got creative and used our artistic skills to produce some beautiful tulip paintings.

## Oak

This week, Oak class have been looking at the similarities and differences between reptiles and amphibians. In art, they have been mixing colours to create their own art work and in maths they have been measuring length using objects.

## Ash

In science we made posters about different animals and what each needs in order to survive. We had great fun in music with the glockenspiels; we made our own pitch patterns using the notes C, E and G to add a layer of sound to a space soundscape - it sounded great!

## Willow

Willow have been investigating shadows! We took advantage of the sunshine on Wednesday and were amazed to see that our shadows 'grew' by up to a metre over the course of the day!

## Cedar

In maths, the children practised adding and subtracting fractions. In RE, they explored the significance of each element of the Holy Communion and Eucharist service. In art, they used tint and shade to create a three-dimensional effect in their work.

## Sycamore

We had a wonderful time at Bishop Ramsey in the Prayer Space, where we reflected, prayed, and took part in a range of meaningful activities. We also enjoyed a fantastic trip to the London Sea Life Aquarium, where we built on our classroom learning about plastic pollution.

## Redwood

In Science, children modelled Darwin's findings from his trip to the Galápagos Islands, using tools to represent different finch beaks. In Spanish, Year 6 used the warm weather to learn ice cream names and practise saying how many scoops they would like.



## Thought for the week



Rejoice always, pray continually, give thanks in all circumstances; for this is God's will for you in Christ Jesus. 1 Thessalonians 5:16-18

This week, we are reminded of three simple but powerful instructions: *rejoice always, pray continually, and give thanks in all circumstances.*
