# How we have flourished this week!

## Seedlings and Acorns

We have been busy retelling The Three Little Pigs, enjoying our 'ice cream parlour,' and making boats and testing if they float. The children were excited to meet our caterpillars, which we will be observing over the coming weeks to see how they grow and change.

## Maple

Maple class have been working hard on number bonds to 10. In English, we began our new story, Handa's Surprise, and used puppets to help us retell the story. In PSHE, we made friendship soup and discussed the qualities needed to be a good friend.

## Oak

We have been looking at the parts of plants in science, finding the mass of objects in maths and painting in the style of Clarice Cliff in art. We have done all this while apating to playtimes and lunchtimes on the Big Playground!

## Ash

In science we dissected bell peppers and apples to find the seeds. We labelled the different parts of these fruits and talked about some differences between seeds and bulbs. In DT we talked about balanced diet and the different food groups. We assessed the Pizza Express menu!

## Willow

This week, Willow have begun learning about plants in Science, poetry in English, the Ancient Egyptians in art and jazz in music! It's been a busy week!

## Cedar

Children have begun exploring decimals, focusing on tenths and building confidence with new concepts. In English, they've been planning and drafting exciting adventure stories full of imagination. In RE, they've started to develop their understanding of Buddhism.

## Sycamore

We started our new History topic on Early Islamic Civilisation. As part of this, we have been learning about the city of Baghdad and why it was such an important centre for learning, culture, and trade during this period.

## Redwood

In RE, pupils have been learning about Pentecost and the history of Christianity, and in English they have been writing in response to the short film Alma, using a range of techniques to create engaging work while really getting into the role of the shopkeeper.
