How we have flourished this week!

Seedlings and Acorns

We have been immersed in the story 'Supertato'. We created our own superhero masks and used positional language to describe where the 'Evil Pea' was hiding around the Nursery. We also measured and compared the heights of different superheroes.

Maple

The children have been learning about grouping and sharing in Maths. Using a teddy bears' picnic, they explored how to share items equally and ensure that each teddy received the same amount. In PSHE, we focused on the importance of exercise..

Oak

This week year one have been learning about explorers of the past. They have been learning about the time in which they lived and what they discovered. They have created papier mache globes to plot the routes taken.

Ash

Year 2 have been fascinated by their new history topic about the monarchy. We have role played the different jobs that King Charles III does. The children asked lots of brilliant questions! In English we have written fantastic, setting descriptions for our new story, 'Anna Hibiscus and the big holiday'.

Willow

This week, Willow have begun a new topic in History, learning about the Ancient Egyptians. In Maths, we are starting to learn about the time using analogue clocks. You can help us at home by referring to the time as often as possible.

Cedar

We began our new maths topic on time, learning about the relationship between seconds, minutes and hours, as well as how to read both digital and analogue clocks. In English, we continued writing our newspaper reports on the effects of plastic pollution.

Sycamore

Sycamore have been learning about faith communities in our local area. In DT, they designed and built truss bridges out of spaghetti and masking tape, applying their knowledge of how triangles can be used to reinforce bridges.

Redwood

This week, Redwood continued writing based on Alma, portraying the character of a doll also trapped by the shopkeeper. The children have started learning the songs for the production in July and preparing for auditions next week!
