# How we have flourished this week!

## Seedlings and Acorns

This week, we learnt about how working as a team can help overcome challenges through the story of 'The Enormous Turnip'. In Maths, we learnt about repeating patterns e.g. ABAB.

## Maple

This week in Maths we have been looking at combining shapes with 4 sides. We looked at winter weather in Science and learnt about animals that hibernate, before creating our own paper plate hedgehogs.

## Oak

This week Oak Class finished their sentence stacking lessons on the Queen's Hat and are looking forward to writing their own story in the same style. They have also continued learning about shape in maths and are almost ready to perform the nativity!

## Ash

Recorder lessons are going really well! The children have learnt to play a fun tune called 'Walking to Wherever', using the notes B and A. They are learning to read rhythms and understand musical notation. We look forward to our nativity next week!

## Willow

This week, Willow have begun learning about estimation in Maths which will help us determine whether our answers to calculations are likely to be accurate. We are also looking forward to our trip next Wednesday to the Natural History Museum!

## Cedar

This week, year 4 have been learning more about how children's lives have changed compared to the children who lived through the Tudor period. They have focused on different ways the children played games compared to now.

## Sycamore

Year 5 wrote their own diaries this week about David Attenborough's expedition to Antarctica to film penguins. In maths they have been learning about equivalent fractions and we have started reading 'The Time Travelling Cat'!

## Redwood

We have completed our class text Goodnight Mr Tom in our Guided Reading lessons! The children discussed how the author used a range of techniques to portray sensitive events and considered the impact of these choices on the reader. They showed great empathy for the characters and began to reflect on people who may face similar circumstances in real life.

Either log in to your account if you have booked with us before, or register for a new account if this is your first time.

3. Add chosen class to basket and check out
4. Once the payment has been made you will receive a confirmation email and shortly after you will be contacted to sign up to the portal where you will be able to view term dates and skill sets. Once done, you will be able to access the portal both on computer and via app to view class dates, weekly assessment results and invoices.




