How we have flourished this week!

Seedlings and Acorns

The children have settled back into Nursery and are enjoying learning about firefighters in our new topic of people who help us and learning their numbers 1 to 5.

Maple

In Maple this week we began a new story in English, 'How to catch a star', looking at friendship. In RE we have started talking about why Jesus is special to Christians. We spoke about people who are special to us and painted a picture of our special person.

Oak

This week, Oak Class have welcomed Miss Ali, who will be with us until half term. We have started learning about toys in history and writing the story of Pinocchio in English.

Ash

In our new English fiction text, Milo has been imagining the world of a boy he spotted on the train. We have been using our own imaginations and brilliant vocabulary to describe features of a palace. For example, magnificent, majestic horses and dazzling, sparkly, jewels.

Willow

This week, Willow have begun thinking about why people live in different settlements around the world in geography, how to begin an observational drawing in art and started learning about pentatonic melodies in music!

Cedar

Happy New Year. This week in Cedar class, children have begun a new English topic based on Charlie and the Chocolate Factory. In RE, they are exploring the big question of how Hindus worship, starting by discussing why they have many images of God.

Sycamore

We have started our new Science topic on Space, where we looked at different theories of the solar system model, and our new History topic on the Tudors, where we explored a range of sources to decide whether Henry VIII was a fair ruler or a tyrant.

Redwood

This week we started reading Pig Heart Boy by Malorie Blackman, and learned about the concept of xenotransplantation - the process of transplanting an animal's organ or tissue into a human. Redwood thought about life from the protagonist's point of view and considered the impacts the decision would have on his life.

At Epiphany, we remember the moment the wise men finally arrived at their destination and met Jesus. Their journey had been long and unpredictable, but they kept following the star because they trusted it would lead them somewhere important. 1. Go to: www.clubspark.lta.org.uk/letsgotennis/caching and click on the long link in the middle of the page. If using a phone, this will download the app. Use the code 3YHEKYFS to access Lets Go Tennis. Either log in to your account if you have booked with us before, or register for a new account if this is your first time.
2. If you need to add a second child to your booking please contact directly
3. Add chosen class to basket and check out
4. Once the payment has been made you will receive a confirmation email and shortly after you will be contacted to sign up to the portal where you will be able to view term dates and skill sets. Once done, you will be able to access the portal both on computer and via app to view class dates, weekly assessment results and invoices.

Our lessons and coaches:
