## UPDATE FROM MR SZURGOT

This week has been another rich and purposeful one across the school, with a strong focus on safety, learning beyond the classroom, and pupil voice.

Children in Years 2, 5 and 6 took part in the NSPCC Speak Out, Stay Safe workshops, which were delivered in an age-appropriate and engaging way. These sessions play an important role in helping children understand how to keep themselves safe, recognise trusted adults, and know where to go for help if they are worried about anything. The children responded thoughtfully and maturely, and we are grateful for the continued support of the NSPCC in this vital area of safeguarding education.

Year 4 enjoyed a valuable visit to the Hindu Temple in Ruislip Manor, as part of their learning in Religious Education. The children were welcomed warmly and had the opportunity to deepen their understanding of Hindu beliefs, practices and worship, bringing their classroom learning to life through first-hand experience.

We were also delighted to welcome Mr Gallup, Chair of Governors, who met with our School Council this week. The children spoke confidently and articulately about what they enjoy about Holy Trinity, what they feel proud of, and what they would like to continue developing. As part of this meeting, the School Council were given a special task to design posters promoting safe and considerate parking, particularly along Kewferry Road. We look forward to sharing their work and continuing to encourage safer parking for the benefit of our whole community.

It has been wonderful to see our pupils engaging so positively in these opportunities and taking increasing ownership of their learning, their safety, and their school environment.

# How we have flourished this week!

## Seedlings and Acorns

This week in Nursery we have been learning about the role of a teacher and the children have enjoyed creating portraits of the Nursery staff. In maths, we have been exploring a range of different patterns.

## Maple

In Maple this week, we finished looking at our non-fiction text, a fact file about penguins. We were introduced to our trigraph 'igh' in Phonics and used our listening skills to complete an obstacle course in PSHE.

## Oak

Oak Class have been busy learning about their sense of hearing. They played 'Guess the Instruments' and went on a 'Sound Walk' to identify sounds around the school. In PSHE they learned all about banks and the services they provide.

## Ash

In English, we have started learning about the Great Fire of London. The children are fascinated by the history and enthusiastic to write great sentences. We are working towards writing a diary entry pretending that we are a rat on the streets of London on 2nd September 1666!

## Willow

This week, Willow have been looking at the links between multiplication and division - something we also practice using Times Table Rock Stars! We have also completed our own stories based on the tale 'The Magic Paintbrush' and were very proud of our work.

## Cedar

The children had an enriching visit to a Hindu temple, learning about traditions and community. In Science, they investigated how quickly ice melts and how temperature changes in cold, warm, and hot water, using thermometers to record accurate measurements.

## Sycamore

This week in science we learnt about how the Earth's rotation causes day and night and how our orbit affects our seasons. We also enjoyed our NSPCC workshop where we learnt how to keep ourselves safe.

## Redwood

This week in Science, the children explored how light travels by making their own periscopes. They discovered how mirrors can change the direction of light and discussed the many ways mirrors are used in everyday life.


