How we have flourished this week!

Seedlings and Acorns

This week in Nursery, we have been learning about the medical profession and have made our own x-rays. In RE we have been reading the parable of the lost sheep and talking about what makes us special.

Maple

This week in Maple we have built on our knowledge of 1 more and have started looking at 1 less. In PSHE we have continued looking at listening to instructions. In English we have been looking at fact files about penguins.

Oak

Oak Class have been impressing with their brilliant story writing about Pinocchio. In science, they have been looking at the sense of sight and investigating if it is easier to get a bean bag in a bucket with no eyes covered, one eye covered or both eyes covered!

Ash

In Music, we chose and layered sounds of the countryside to create another 'soundscape'. The children enjoyed making music to paint a picture. We also listened to 'The Lark Ascending' by Vaughan Williams and identified how the changes in pitch help describe a bird in flight.

Willow

This week Willow have continued to focus on their times tables in maths and we hope everyone is enjoying using Times Table Rockstars at home. In Music, we have continued to use pentatonic scales and are looking forward to sharing this with you!

Cedar

Pupils completed an independent write on Charlie and the Chocolate Factory (the Chocolate Room), researched key individuals who helped uncover the history of the Indus Valley, and in Maths developed their skills dividing two- and three-digit numbers.

Sycamore

This week we have been: planning the transmissions from our imaginary planets; we visited the Science Museum and saw the 3D film all about our planet; learnt about the phases of the moon due to its orbit and written an algorithm for the Mars Rover.

Redwood

This week, we read the next chapter of Pig Heart Boy and discussed the author's intent and the characters' feelings. In Badminton, the children began playing doubles, working collaboratively with their partners to move effectively around the court and apply game strategies.

Loving God,


Thank you for your goodness and for your love that lasts forever.


