# How we have flourished this week!

## Seedlings and Acorns

This week, in Nursery we learnt about the importance of working hard with dedication to complete tasks through the story of the 'Three Little Pigs' where the third pig's house was strong and rewarded the other pigs protection from the wolf.

## Maple

This week, in Maths, we have been looking at 1 more and 1 less. We have used songs and some drama to help with our understanding of this. In RE we spoke about all the different ways that our families prepare for Christmas.

## Oak

This week, year one have been writing fabulous stories and the Queen's hat. They have also been exploring 3D shape in maths and learning about absorbency in science.

## Ash

Ash Class did themselves very proud this week on their visit to the RAF Museum. They were engaged and excited to learn; they listened beautifully during the workshop, and they impressed our leader with their knowledge!

## Willow

This week, Willow have been learning about the formation of mountains and volcanoes in Geography. In particular, we have been focusing on volcanoes, thinking about why some people might live close to them.

## Cedar

This week, the children built electrical circuits, experimenting with components and learning how power flows. They also explored the kinds of work Tudor children did, using sources to understand how different their lives were from today.

## Sycamore

In science, we explored the transparency of different materials and their uses. In geography, we studied Innsbruck, looking at what there is to do there and why people may choose to visit.

## Redwood

In Science, Redwood measured shadows and investigated how the size of the shadow is affected by the distance between the object and surface. In History, we used census data to understand the jobs available in the Victorian Era.



## Thought for the week



The Lord told Jonah, "Go to the great city of Nineveh and tell them to turn from their evil ways." Jonah 3:1-2

Jonah's story reminds us that sometimes we are called to do things that feel challenging, uncomfortable, or even a little scary. Jonah didn't want to go to Nineveh at first, but God gave him a second chance - and Jonah chose to listen. Because of his courage and obedience, a whole city changed for the better.

In our school community, we all have opportunities to make good choices, to show kindness, and to help others turn things around when they are not going down the right path. Jonah teaches us that doing the right thing can make a big difference, and that God is always ready to guide us, even when the task seems big.

Either log in to your account if you have booked with us before, or register for a new account if this is your first time.
2. If you need to add a second child to your booking please contact directly
3. Add chosen class to basket and check out
4. Once the payment has been made you will receive a confirmation email and shortly after you will be contacted to sign up to the portal where you will be able to view term dates and skill sets. Once done, you will be able to access the portal both on computer and via app to view class dates, weekly assessment results and invoices.
