

How we have flourished this week!

Seedlings and Acorns

This week, we practised counting to 10 and learnt about the features of foxes as one of the characters from the story of the 'Gingerbread Man'. We also learnt about how Christmas is celebrated around the world.

Maple

This week, the children were introduced to the team game 'Articulate! For kids', to support their understanding of grammar. They have used adjectives and verbs to give clear descriptions of different things such as 'skipping rope', 'uniform' and 'blinking'.

Oak

This week, Oak class have been producing some excellent creative writing including onomatopoeia about the Queen and Buckingham Palace. Rehearsals have also been underway for our nativity!

Ash

This week, the children were introduced to the team game 'Articulate! For kids', to support their understanding of grammar. They have used adjectives and verbs to give clear descriptions of different things such as 'skipping rope', 'uniform' and 'blinking' to win points for their team.

Willow

Willow have been working with care to complete their assessments this week. We have also been using the glockenspiels to create a range of different moods for our soundscapes!

Cedar

This week Year 4 explored how Jesus' message of peace is relevant today by interpreting Bible texts. They also continued studying how children's lives have changed over time, focusing on the experiences and daily routines of children in the Tudor period.

Sycamore

In geography this week we used maps to find out where the Alps were located. On Wednesday we had a great time getting to know children from BWI and listening to David Walliams. In Spanish we learnt how to say where we lived and sing Happy Birthday.

Redwood

This week in RE, Redwood completed a biblical analysis of Jesus' birth, comparing the four gospels and discussing why each includes different details. In History, the children learned how the Victorian census worked and explored the challenges faced by enumerators.

1. Go to: www.clubspark.lta.org.uk/letsgotennis/caching and click on the long link in the middle of the page. If using a phone, this will download the app. Use the code 3YHEKYFS to access Lets Go Tennis. Either log in to your account if you have booked with us before, or register for a new account if this is your first time.
2. If you need to add a second child to your booking please contact directly
3. Add chosen class to basket and check out
4. Once the payment has been made you will receive a confirmation email and shortly after you will be contacted to sign up to the portal where you will be able to view term dates and skill sets. Once done, you will be able to access the portal both on computer and via app to view class dates, weekly assessment results and invoices.

Our lessons and coaches:

All sessions are run by LTA qualified coaches who are DBS checked and first aid trained. All lessons will involve technical and tactical work on all major shots as well as match play where possible. In case of bad weather either an indoor classroom lesson will be held or a lesson in the hall if possible. We will provide all necessary equipment.
