Covid-19 Measures Reminder

- If your child has been in close contact with someone with Covid-19 **as long as they have completed a LFD (lateral flow device) test daily, they can attend school but you must communicate your child's test results daily to Mrs Hunt via welfare@holytrinitynorthwood.org and through the Government [Online Reporting System](#).**
- If your child has any of the main symptoms of COVID-19, even if they are mild, they must get a PCR test to check if they have COVID-19 as soon as possible. Your child must self-isolate until you get the test result.
